Project One: Heart Suncatchers

Materials:

- Glue
- Colored tissue paper
- Wax paper
- Scissors
- String
- Hole punch

Create!

1. Take a sheet of wax paper and cut out a heart shape. You can either draw this first or fold the wax paper in half and cut it that way.
2. Once you have your heart shape, start to rip various colors of tissue paper and arrange them on your heart the way you want them.
3. Once you have arranged the tissue paper, glue them down onto the heart.
4. Cut off the remaining tissue paper that hangs over the edge of the heart.
5. Use the hole punch to create a hole in the top-center part of the heart.
6. Tie some string in order to hang your suncatcher on the window.
7. Watch the colors shine through as the sun is out!

Project Two: Fingerprint Sheep

Materials:

- Construction paper
- White paint
- Googly eyes
- Glue
- Black paper

Create!

1. Start by cutting out four skinny rectangles for the sheep's legs. This will give you an idea of where to stamp the paint for the sheep wool. You can also cut out the sheep's head and tail at this stage.
2. Glue the legs, head, and tail onto a piece of construction paper.
3. Dip your thumb or finger into white paint and stamp away! Make it look almost like a cloud of white fingerprints.
4. Once the paint has dried glue the googly eyes to the sheep's head.
