Project One: String Cross

Materials:

- Two large and two small popsicle sticks (or a cardboard square)
- String
- Scissors
- Markers or other coloring supplies
- Glue

Create!

1. If you do not have popsicle sticks, create a square with cardboard and cut a smaller square on the inside, making a frame. If you choose to use popsicle sticks, glue them together to make a rectangular frame. Using two large popsicle sticks and two smaller ones works best.
2. Decorate your frame however you would like. Write Bible verses on it, color it, draw a cool design, whatever you choose!
3. Once your frame is done, or dry, take the string and begin wrapping it around the frame vertically, making sure to tie the ends together once you’ve finished.
4. Repeat this process horizontally, making sure the strings are high enough to make a cross, not a plus sign.
5. Lastly, wrap the string around the center of the cross where the two meet. This will help keep the cross in place.

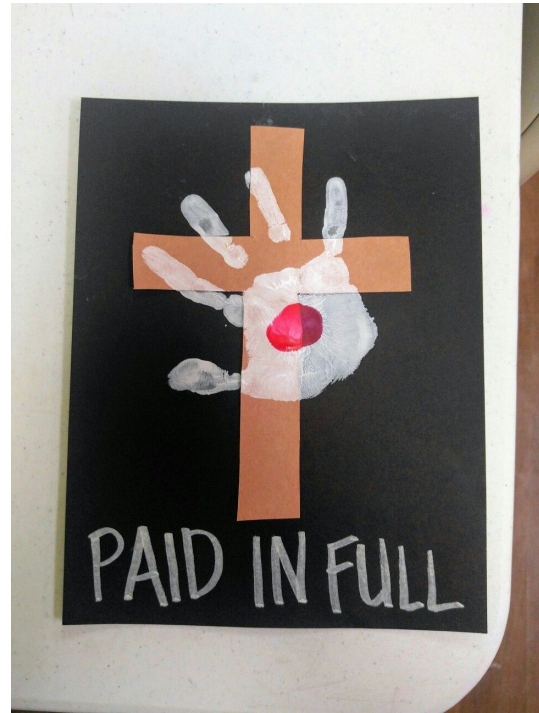
Project Two: Paid in Full

Materials:

- Construction paper
- White Paint
- Red Paint
- Brown Paper

Create!

1. Taking a brown piece of construction paper, cut out a cross that will fit the size of another piece of construction paper.
2. Glue the cross to a piece of construction paper with the color of your choice.
3. Taking a paintbrush, paint your hand with the white paint and place it over the cross.
4. With your finger, take red paint and create a dot in the center of your handprint.
5. Once the paint has dried, or while it is drying, write "Paid in Full" on the paper as a reminder that all of your sins are forgiven and you are saved through Jesus Christ.
