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Before You Arrive to Camp Omega's Family Camp!

Greetings to you, family campers! We are pleased to have the opportunity to serve you this summer and provide opportunities for you to grow closer as a family and deeper in the faith of our risen Savior, Jesus Christ. In order to preserve the safety of all guests and staff, we require that you review these statements prior to your arrival at camp.

- Neither I nor any members of my group/family have tested positive for COVID or been in close proximity with someone who has been tested for, diagnosed with, or quarantined as a result of COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- 2) In the last 14 days, neither I nor any members of my group/family have shown any symptoms of COVID-19, such as: fever, body aches, fatigue, cough, shortness of breath, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or limited sense of smell or taste.
- 3) In the last 14 days, neither I nor any members of my group/family have travelled out of the state.

If any of the above apply to you or any members of your group, please stay home. Help be part of the global solution and help slow the spread. A full refund will be provided should you need to cancel due to the above requirements.

Once you arrive at Camp Omega, we need your help in keeping the camp community safe by adhering to the following:

- Please monitor yourself and all members of your group/family for COVID-19. In the event of developing COVID symptoms or being diagnosed with COVID-19 during your stay, you will notify the Camp Omega staff, depart immediately and follow the Department of Health guidelines for isolating.
- 2) Respect the health and well-being of yourself, fellow guests, and the Camp Omega staff by following guidelines for physical distancing and virus prevention. This includes regular hand washing and use of sanitizer, remaining at least 6ft apart from members outside of your household/group and following all food service procedures as established by camp.
- 3) The Camp Omega staff will practice all disinfecting prevention methods to keep guests safe, however, guests will need to provide their own Personal Protection Equipment i.e. masks, gloves, etc... as desired.
- 4) While the camp does typically provide recreational equipment for guests, it's advisable that guests bring their own to help reduce chances of spreading the virus. Examples of equipment are life jackets, paddles, basketball, volleyball, rubber playground ball, frisbee, or disc golf discs.
